# **Priorities/Guidelines/Program Fit**


- Project fit with type funder wants?

#### **Amount Funded**

- \$\$ range? Is it worth the work?
- How much more do you need?
- Matching funds required?
- "Admin" costs covered?





# **Geographic Focus**

- Within geographic area funded?
- Local, regional, national?





#### **Ease of Application**

- LOI first?
- How complicated?
- Page/word character limit?
- How much info do you have to gather?
- Existing vs. new program?
- How much program development needed?

- New vs. "recycled" language
- Who else?
- Reporting requirements?
- Time needed?
- Next opportunity?
